REQUIREMENTS

1. A completed application form includes:
 - 1. A \$40.00 fee payable to the Women's Musical Club of Winnipeg, and privacy signature below.
 - 2. Written letter of agreement from the present teacher or head of school of music in which candidate is enrolled.
 - 3. A confidential statement from one person who is in a position to judge the personal, musical and academic qualities of the candidate. This person **cannot** be the current teacher or a relative.
 - 4. A brief statement by the candidate of his/her musical aims.
 - 5. A list of the applicant's choice of selected music. **See criteria of appropriate music selection below.**

CRITERIA FOR MUSIC SELECTION/PERFORMANCE

1. Music selection must be of diploma level.
 2. A single movement of a multi movement piece is acceptable.
 3. The adjudicators may not require the complete performance of any selection.
 4. **2 Original** (no photocopies) copies of the music must be given to adjudicators.
 5. Instrumentalists must prepare a minimum of three compositions of contrasting style and period with a total time of not less than fifteen minutes or more than twenty minutes.
 6. Vocalists must prepare a group of songs of contrasting style and language with a total time of not less than ten minutes and not more than fifteen minutes.
 7. **Exact** time of each selection must be stated.
2. These scholarships are intended for **Manitoba students**. Out-of-province students who reside temporarily in Manitoba for their music studies are not eligible.
 3. Age requirements as of May 31: Instrumentalist: 17 to 27 years
Vocalists: 19 to 30 years
 4. No application will be considered from a student who has had three previous auditions or who has been a first place winner.
 5. Applicants must display outstanding musical talent, have a high standard of performance and a good general academic standing.
 6. Refunds of the registration fee will not be given if the candidate withdraws after the deadline for the application.

REGULATIONS

It is understood and agreed that:

- a) The filing of this application does not bind the Women's Musical Club to provide an audition. (maximum 28 auditions)
- b) Not more than three applications from any one teacher will be accepted.
- c) The recommendation of the Club's adjudication committee is final and not subject to appeal.
- d) As part of the scholarship award, winners will be expected to perform at the annual Scholarship Concert which is part of the Subscription Series of the Women's Musical Club of Winnipeg. The scholarship cheques will be given at this concert which takes place late December. (December 30, 2010, 7:00 pm, at the Art Gallery)
- e) Candidates must be prepared to meet their own traveling, maintenance and accompanist expenses for the audition and the concert.
- f) The winners of this competition will be announced to the public the next day and any information in this application may be used in further publicity regarding these scholarships.
